What is a Hunter Pace?

Our hunter pace is essentially a mock-hunt with fantastic cross country schooling, including roll tops, coops, banks / mounds, ditches and the main Chattahoochee Water Complex; with no hounds or prey, where the goal is to complete a course in a time predetermined to be optimum for your division / level. The various cross country jumps, and obstacles along the course may or may not be jumped, “jumping any obstacle at all levels is optional”. You will be timed, and whoever gets closest to the optimum time, whether faster or slower, wins that division.

Open to ALL DISCIPLINES! Eventing, Hunter/Jumper, Dressage, Pleasure, Western and Trail Riders! It is a great way to “dip your toes” into the sport of eventing or foxhunting, or just to get your horse and yourself some field experience.

The main goal is to have fun and enjoy the countryside with your horse! Prizes will be given after the last horse has returned from the course. Food will be available for sale on the property; however you may want to pack a lunch and drinks to enjoy after your ride. Tailgating is encouraged!

The cross country course will be open for schooling immediately after awards and prizes are given out; All schooling will be an additional \$25 Cost to Horses entered in the Hunter Pace Schooling is \$50 for those not entered in the Hunter Pace; This will be the last day for XC schooling before the 2010 AEC.

Overnight stabling available; \$40 per night per horse; please call ahead to book a stall. Bring your own bedding or will be available for sale on site; \$8.00 per bag.
